

**COMMON COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION
FEBRUARY 02, 2026
7:00 P.M.**

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in a Regular Session on Monday February 2, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the temporary Council Chambers at the Warsaw Police Department Training Center. Mayor Jeff R. Grose presided, and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

PRESENT: Present were Council members Cindy Dobbins, Juergen Voss, Josh Finch, Michael Klondaris, Jerry Frush, and Diane Quance. Also present were Mayor Jeff R. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Grose followed by the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES-

The minutes from the January 20, 2026 Regular Session were presented for approval. Councilor Frush made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Councilor Dobbins, carried by unanimous vote

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS-

-An Oath of Office was given to Max Mailie, Warsaw Board of Zoning Appeals.

REPORTS/ORAL & WRITTEN COMMUNICATION-

UNFINISHED BUSINESS-

ORDINANCE/FINES AND PENALTIES FOR PARKING-

Ordinance #2026-01-01 was presented for second reading. The Ordinance amends and updates Chapter 2, Article IV of the City Code by increasing civil penalties for parking related offenses as further described in the Ordinance. After further discussion Councilor Dobbins made a motion to approve Ordinance #2026-01-01 on second and final reading, seconded by Councilor Frush, carried by unanimous vote.

ORDINANCE/GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS-

Ordinance #2026-01-02 was presented for second reading. The Ordinance amends and updates Chapter 74, Article V of general parking regulations of the City Code. The amendments and updates are key to the downtown parking area that will be changing to a digital parking system to improve parking management. After discussion, Councilor Quance made a motion to approve Ordinance #2026-01-02 on second and final reading, seconded by Councilor Finch, carried by unanimous vote.

NEW BUSINESS-

2026 ELECTED SALARY ORDINANCE AMENDMENT-

Ordinance #2026-02-01 was presented for approval. The Ordinance amends the 2026 Elected Salary Ordinance by adding a 10% premium for Council President and converts Council pay to monthly amounts. Motion made by Councilor Finch to table the ordinance, seconded by Councilor Dobbins, carried by unanimous vote.
