

**COMMON COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION
March 2, 2026
7:00 P.M.**

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in Regular Session on Monday, March 2, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the temporary Council Chambers at the Police Department training center. Mayor Jeff R. Grose presided and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING/INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (INDOT)-

Director of Public Works Dustin Dillon presented a Letter of Understanding from INDOT. The letter addresses and describes an unofficial detour, as early as Spring of 2027, for bridge deck overlay work on US 30 overpass at SR 15. All of the east and west bound lanes of US 30 at the bridge will be closed, causing local traffic to be detoured on routes designated in the letter. After discussion, Councilor Dobbins made a motion to approve the proposed detours, seconded by Councilor Wilhite, carried by unanimous vote.

RESOLUTION/KOSCIUSKO COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN-

Kosciusko County Emergency Management Director Kip Shuter presented the Kosciusko County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. Also included was **Resolution #2026-03-02** for the Council to adopt the plan. By adopting the plan the City will be eligible to apply and receive project grants for mitigation funds that may inhibit hazards and improve safety. Motion made by Councilor Dobbins to approve the resolution and plan, seconded by Councilor Voss carried by unanimous vote.
