

**COMMON COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION
May 4, 2026
7:00 P.M.**

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in a Regular Session on Monday, May 4, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the temporary Council Chambers at the Police Department Training Center. Mayor Jeff R. Grose presided, and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

ORDINANCE REGULATING LAW ENFORCEMENT VIDEO RECORDING FEES-

Ordinance #2026-04-01 was presented for its second reading. The Ordinance defines law enforcement activity and recordings from body cameras and in-car cameras and fees associated with copying the videos when requested as further described in the Ordinance. After discussion Councilor Finch made a motion to approve the Ordinance on second and final reading, seconded by Councilor Wilhite, carried by unanimous vote.
