Development of the Parson Farm is ready for asphalt.

To date there have been 138 pounds of fresh vegetables given to the Salvation Army.

Hal informed the Board the Cemetery Walk had approximately 175 that attended. It was a successful event.

Hal advised that Danielle Morris has filled the Administrative Assistant position.

Under New Business:
