An American flag burn barrel to properly dispose of tattered America flags. It will sit opposite of the bell at the Preacher Stand.

Ken told the Board that he had a phone conference set up with Bob Dockery from Wreaths Across America.

Under New Business:

Hal introduced Howard Kistler to the Board as his Assistant/Supervisor at the Cemetery.

The Spring cleanup has begun as well as the maintenance on the grounds.

They have thirty-six foundations ready to pour once the weather allows. As well as getting ready to work on cutting sod.

Hal informed the Board they have ordered a new 2025 Gator utility vehicle. They will be trading in their 2017 Gator.

The extension of #3 Cremation Garden should begin soon. These will be continued as ground burials.

Hal contacted Derry Electric for a quote to run underground electric from chapel to #3 Legion Circle so it would illuminate the military flags.
